# Rain Check Program Background




- Gives property owners rebates for installing stormwater management practices

Stormwater is created when rainwater runs across the landscape, picking up pollutants and debris as it travels to local waterways.





# Benefits


- **Citizens**
  - Lowers your Clean Water Act Fee
  - Reduces backyard erosion, pooling and flooding
  - Beautifies properties and increases property value
- **Community**
  - Reduces flash flooding
  - Improves air quality and conserves water
- **County**
  - Supports the County's Watershed Implementation Plan





# Maximum Rebate Per Property

- \$2,000 maximum residential rebate
- \$20,000 maximum rebate for commercial properties and multi-family dwellings
- Rebate amount cannot exceed the cost of the project



# How to Get Your Rebate



1

a) Determine what practices are suitable for your property

2


- a) Fill out and submit the rebate application
- b) Schedule a pre-installation site visit for all practices except rain barrels

3

- a) Install the practice within 12 months of approval
- b) Schedule a post-installation site visit

4

- a) Submit receipts to the Chesapeake Bay Trust (CBT)
- b) Receive rebate check
