












# 2011 Commercial Robberies by Day of Week




# 2011 Commercial Robberies by Time of Day




# 2011 Citizen Robberies by Day of Week




# 2011 Citizen Robberies by Time of Day




# 2011 Commercial Burglaries by Day of Week




# 2011 Residential Burglaries by Day of Week



# 2011 Vehicle Thefts by Day of Week








# ***Total Crime by Ward 2011***




# Crime By Ward 5 Year Comparison




# ***Reported Crime Five Year Comparison***

# Crime Clearance Comparisons 2011 HCPD & 2010 UCR








