


Values






Commercial Robberies by Day & Time




Citizen Robberies by Day & Time 2014






Heat Map of Robberies in 2014




Residential Burglaries by Day 2014






Vehicle Thefts by Day 2014



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


Thefts from Vehicles by Day 2014








Combined Crimes by Day 2014



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






Total Crime by Type 2014




Persons and Property Crimes 2014



Crime by Ward 2014














Photo Traffic Enforcement 5 Year Comparison




Police Reports 5 Year Comparison




Citizen & Officer Generated Calls for Service 5 Year Comparison


Citizen & Officer Generated Calls for Service by Month




Citizen and Officer Generated Calls for Service by Day


During the course of that involvement, please rate the overall competence of our employees.





- If, during the past 3 years, you had any involvement with our officers, please rate their attitude and behavior





- In your opinion, how would you measure your level of concern over safety and security in the City as a whole?

2014 Goals, Objectives & Performance Measures

- Police Goal 1: Control crime, fear, and disorder
- Objective: Residents receive regular, accurate reports on crime & enforcement data
- Measure: Compilation and distribution of data is provided per City schedule no less than 85% of the time
- Status: Crime data is uploaded to www.crimereports.com once every 24 hours. Monthly reports are posted to the website. Media reports are distributed weekly. A citizen survey was conducted via the website for 60 days


