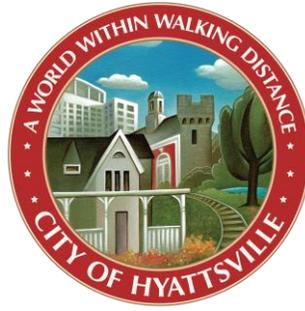

Free, non-appointment COVID-19 testing begins in the City of Hyattsville on June 15

HYATTSVILLE, MD - Free COVID-19 testing will be available starting Monday, June 15, 2020 at the First United Methodist Church of Hyattsville, 6201 Belcrest Rd, Hyattsville, MD 20782, as part of a partnership between the Church, Luminis Health, and the City of Hyattsville. The testing site will offer drive-through and walk-up testing on Mondays, Thursdays, and Saturdays between the hours of 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

No appointments will be needed to receive a test. Tests will be administered by the staff of Luminis Health, who have the capacity to deliver a maximum of 200 tests per day with kits provided by the Prince George's County Health Department. Those being tested can expect results in 24-48 hours.

Testing will take place in large tents, preceded by registration at smaller tents. Drivers should enter the parking lot of the Church using the entrance on MD Route 410 (East-West Highway). Walk-up tests will be conducted at the front of the Church facing Belcrest Road. Everyone is asked to follow traffic guidance as directed by the City of Hyattsville Police Department.

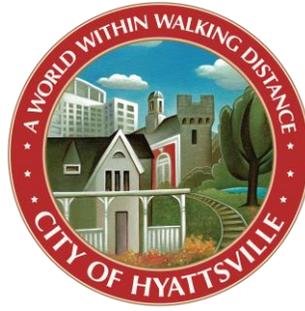
