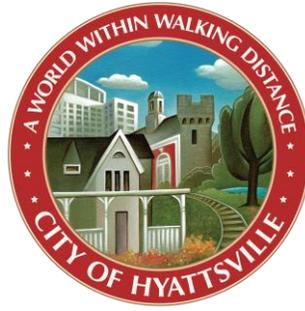

**Media Advisory: New COVID-19 vaccination site opening in Hyattsville**

HYATTSVILLE, MD - A new COVID-19 vaccination site located inside the First United Methodist Church of Hyattsville will be offering a limited run of appointments today, February 24, 2021 from 1 p.m. – 3 p.m. Members of the media are invited to observe the vaccination process and speak with staff operating the site. The site is being operated by a partnership between the City, Luminis Health, the Prince George's County Department of Health, and the First United Methodist Church of Hyattsville. County residents must have an appointment through the Prince George's County Department of Health to receive a vaccine at this site.

Prince George's County residents in Group 1 of the County's vaccine distribution plan can pre-register for appointments at [mypgc.us/COVIDVaccine](http://mypgc.us/COVIDVaccine). Prince George's County will contact those who have completed the pre-registration form with more information about scheduling an appointment.

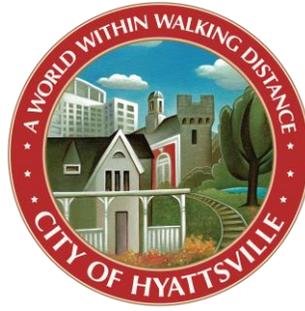
Vaccinations will take place in the Church's Fellowship Hall. Access to the vaccination site is available through the Church's entrance off Queens Chapel Road.

COVID-19 testing will continue to be offered in the Church's parking lot on Mondays, Thursdays, and Saturdays from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. or until the site reaches capacity. Those seeking COVID-19 tests can access drive-through testing using the parking lot entrance on East-West Highway and walk-up testing using the parking lot entrance on Belcrest Road.
